### 19th Century Europe

Congress of Vienna - Sept 1814

Age of Metternich - Prince Metternich of Austria

- To return things as they were before the Napoleonic Era
- BUT not restoring Holy Roman Empire
- Restoring Royal family to France
- Establishing new balance of power in Europe
- Holy Roman Empire becomes the German Confederation



### France - the continuing saga

- Louis XVIII brother of Louis XVI (Louis XVII is the son who died who never formally reigned)
- Charles X brother of Louis XVIII

Paris did not like him so they revolted The July Revolution Of 1830 (Les Miserables)

- Louis Philippe
- Louis Napoleon (Emperor Napoleon III)

When people of France longed for the days of strong leadership they elected the nephew of Napoleon Elected president of Second Republic

Proclaimed himself Emperor Napoleon III - 1852

### Italy

- 1831 Mazzini & Garibaldi started "Young Italy" secret society for Italian independence unification through violence
- Victor Emmanuel II became the 1st King of United Italy

# In 1848 after publication of the *Communist Manifesto* by Karl Marx & Frederick Engels... Austria

• In 1848, Austrians revolted and Prince Metternich fled to England
