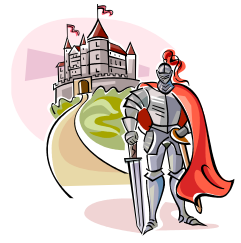

Plantagenet Kings

- Henry II - common law, trial by jury, Thomas 'a Becket
- Richard I (Richard the Lion-Hearted)
- Eleanor of Aquitaine
- King John - most hated king in English history!
 - Papal Interdict over England
 - Runnymede & The Magna Carta
- Edward I (Edward Longshanks) - Model Parliament, bills & Edward II
 - William Wallace / Robert the Bruce
- Edward III & development of House of Commons & House of Lords

Hundred Years' War - England versus France

- Battles of Crecy, Poitiers, Agincourt
- Joan of Arc - the Maid of Orleans
- Hundred Years' War ended Plantagenet Dynasty with defeat of Richard II

- Wars of the Roses (1455 - 1485): House of Lancaster versus House of York
- Lancaster - Red Rose & York - White Rose
